Meeting your needs. Should you have any questions or special requests, please don't hesitate to ask. Just because a specific option has not been listed does not mean it's unavailable. We are honored to plan a funeral service tailored specifically to your needs.

Our Packages. The goods and services we offer are listed below. You will notice that our price list includes both "Packages" and itemized pricing. The Federal Trade Commission requires this to ensure that you, as a consumer, know you have the right to choose only the items you want. Typically, choosing a package, which includes a basic services and overhead fee of \$3,000, is more cost-effective than itemized selections.

Legal Regulations. There may be instances where legal regulations require the purchase of items you did not specifically request. If this occurs, we will provide a written explanation on the Statement of Goods and Services. For inquiries about your funeral agreement, you can contact us directly. If you have questions regarding regulations that apply to your funeral agreement, please contact the Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies at (303) 894-7855.

No Embalming. The Natural Funeral focuses on natural death care and does not perform embalming. In Colorado, embalming is not legally required. The regulations for natural burial, including the requirements for grave liners and outer burial containers, may vary by cemetery.

Pricing. To guarantee pricing, discuss prepayment with us. For individuals on hospice, we will honor the price quote provided at the original time of contact. Pricing does not include applicable sales taxes.

Payments. Payment is required prior to the delivery of services. We accept cash, checks, cashier's checks, ACH transfers, Venmo, money orders, pre-funded arrangements, verified life insurance assignments with a 4% service fee, and credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover).

ITEMIZED PRICE LIST

Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff - \$3,000

This is the only fee that is not declinable and is already included in our charges for direct packages.

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of service/tribute; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of our online obituary notice; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., clergy, church, cemetery, crematory, and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building, software, utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, secretarial and administrative expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct ("Limited") fire cremations, water cremations, and terramations, immediate ("Limited") burials, and forwarding or receiving of deceased.)

Should you choose "itemized" arrangements, the fee for our basic services will be added to the final cost.

 - Our charge includes basic services of the funeral director and staff; removal of remains; preparation of remains, shelter of remains for up to 5 days, if appropriate; and local transport. You may purchase a casket from our funeral home, or we can ship using only an air tray. NOTE: The airline ticket or the cost of the air tray (required) is not included in our price.
- Receiving the Body from Another Funeral Home - \$3,000
 - Our charge includes basic services of the funeral director and staff; shelter of remains for up to 5 days; transport of remains within 30 miles or from DIA to the funeral home.
